To provide safe and secure medical care to outpatients, we have issued this Important Notice. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

【Important Notice】

- ◆ We are a medical institution providing primary emergency care services. The members of the Nagoya City Medical Association take turns to provide medical care services at our center. Therefore, if the duty doctor is not specialized in your symptoms, we may introduce a secondary medical institution to you. Thank you for your understanding in advance.
- ◆ After consultation, treatments (such as intravenous drips, inhalation, etc.) and various examinations are administered as deemed necessary by the duty doctor, which means that patients cannot request medical treatments or examinations.
- ◆ Our center is a medical institution for primary emergency medical care; therefore, we give minimum prescription drugs (as a rule, generally for one day or a few days in the case of weekends/holidays) as emergency measures.
- ◆ If your symptoms do not improve after receiving medical services at our center or if you still worry about your symptoms, be sure to visit your family doctor or a medical institution specialized in your symptoms on a weekday.
- ◆ Our staff will assess whether you are infected with COVID-19 or influenza. Please follow their instructions regarding waiting areas, consultation order, and payment.
- ◆ Please understand that the consultation order may change depending on the condition of patients.
- ◆ We do not issue certificates regarding recovery from COVID-19, influenza, or other infectious diseases.
